Overview

Establishes a matching grant program to help school districts pay agricultural education teachers to work with students in extended programs over the summer.

- 1 Agricultural educator grants.
 - **Subd. 1 Grant program established.** Establishes a grant program to help school districts pay agricultural education teachers to work with students in extended programs over the summer.
 - **Subd. 2. Application.** Directs the education commissioner to develop the form and manner for applying for the grants and the criteria for allocating the grants, including appropriate goals for using the grants.
 - **Subd. 3. Grant awards.** Requires school districts to match the amount of the grant funding. Limits grant funding for a teacher to one-half share of 40 working days.
 - **Subd. 4. Reports.** Requires school districts receiving grants to annually report to the education commissioner by December 1 on the number of teachers funded by the grants and the outcomes compared to the goals in the grant application. Directs the education department to develop report criteria.
- **Appropriation.** Appropriates unspecified general fund amounts to the education department in fiscal years 2016 and 2017 for agricultural educator grants.
