## Overview

This bill provides for allowing electronic storage of records on motor vehicle and driver licensing transactions that have been handled by deputy registrars (who operate motor vehicle registration and titling offices under authorization by the Department of Public Safety) and driver's license agents (who similarly operate driver licensing offices).

## Section

- 1 **Deputy registrars.** Permits deputy registrars to store motor vehicle transaction records electronically after 60 days and subject to Department of Public Safety requirements. Makes deputy registrars responsible for associated costs.
- **Application.** Permits entities (identified as a deputy registrars but presumably driver's license agents) to store motor vehicle transaction records electronically after 60 days and subject to Department of Public Safety requirements. Makes the entity responsible for associated costs.
- **Deputy registrar electronic storage standards.** Directs the Department of Public Safety to develop, by August 1, 2015, standards on secure electronic storage of data as well as paper destruction procedures.
