Overview

House File 1182 requires applications for hunting and fishing licenses obtained from the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) or a deputy registrar of motor vehicles to allow an applicant to become an organ donor.

Section

- 1 [97A.408] Anatomical gift; donor records; donation. Requires applications for resident hunting and fishing licenses obtained from the DNR, its Web site, or a motor vehicle deputy registrar to allow an applicant to become an organ donor. Describes information about the organ donation process that must accompany the application. Specifies that a certified organ procurement organization must be allowed reasonable access to DNR records to ascertain whether a licensee at or near death is an organ donor. Prescribes that the donor designation can be removed only by written notice to the DNR. Provides that the DNR must be reimbursed for the administrative costs of the program from the account in section 2.
- [171.075] subd. 1. Anatomical gift account. Provides for reimbursement to state agencies for administrative costs associated with an organ donor program from the existing account used to reimburse the driver and vehicle services division for implementing the organ donor program in association with drivers' license applications.
- Interim report. Requires the DNR commissioner to submit a report on the implementation of this act to the legislative committees with jurisdiction over natural resources policy by January 1, 2016.
