Overview

Provides an additional \$20 million in city LGA to cities that are not eligible for existing municipal street aid to be used to fund road and bridge construction and maintenance. All cities with a population under 5,000 would currently be eligible. Effective beginning with aids payable in 2016.

Section

- 1 Additional aid for transportation funding. Provides additional aid to cities not eligible to receive funds from the municipal street aid account (cities with a population under 5,000). This additional aid must be used for road and bridge construction and maintenance. The amount of aid going to each cities is the same amount per capita, with the per capita amount set to spend the total appropriation in section 2
- 2 **Cities (appropriation).** Provides an additional \$20 million annually, beginning with aids payable in 2016, to fund the new aid authorized in section 1.
