This bill does not make any substantive changes to the law, but recodifies many of the subdivisions under section 340A.301, which governs liquor manufacturer and wholesaler licenses. The subdivisions relating to brew pubs, brewer taprooms, small brewers, and growler sales are assigned by this proposed law to their own sections under chapter 340A and reorganized for clarity. The subdivision authorizing microdistillery license fees is moved to the microdistillery section. In addition, the current definition of “brew pub” is extracted from section 340A.301, subdivision 6(d), and added to the definitions section of 340A.101. Other modifications have been made for clarity.
