Workers' compensation judges. Current law provides that workers' compensation judges must be state employees, unless all regularly appointed judges are disqualified from a case under the Code of Judicial Conduct. This section provides that when regularly appointed workers' compensation judges are not available, the chief administrative law judge may contract with a retired workers' compensation judge.
