## Overview

This bill extends the expiration of the E-Health Advisory Committee, the Trauma Advisory Committee, and the Maternal and Child Health Advisory Task Force. The bill also encourages the Maternal and Child Health Advisory Task Force to conduct a review on information relating to stillbirths.

## **Section**

- **E-Health advisory committee.** Amends § 62J.495, subdivision 2. Changes committee expiration from June 30, 2015, to June 20, 2021.
- **Council administration.** Amends § 144.608, subdivision 2. Changes the Trauma Advisory Task Force expiration from June 30, 2015, to June 20, 2025.
- **Composition of task force.** Amends § 145.8811, subdivision 1. Changes the Maternal and Child Health Advisory Task Force expiration from June 30, 2015, to no expiration.
- **Stillbirth review.** Encourages the Maternal and Child Health Advisory Task Force to conduct a review of current methods of data collection, protocols to prevent stillbirth, available support for families, and other stillbirth related information as deemed appropriate by the task force.
