Overview

This bill modifies a licensing requirement for osteopathic physicians, updates titles, and makes technical changes to the composition of the Board of Medical Practice.

Section

- 1 **Creation; terms.** Amends § 147.01, subd. 1. Makes technical changes to modify language related to the composition of the Board of Medical Practice.
- 2 **Recommendations for appointment.** Amends § 147.01, subd. 2. Makes technical changes by updating “doctor of osteopathy” to “osteopathic physician.”
- 3 **United States or Canadian medical school graduates.** Amends § 147.02, subd. 1. Updates the name of a licensing examination. Allows applicants nine attempts to pass the exam. The limit in current law is six attempts.
