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Subject:	Minnesota Revised Uniform Limited Liability Company Act		
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Overview

This bill makes clarifying and technical changes relating to the Minnesota Revised Uniform Limited Liability Company Act ("Revised Act").

Section

- **1-14 Corrects cross-reference.** Inserts references to the Revised Act.
- 15 Grammar. Makes grammatical changes.
- **16 18** Fees. States the fees for different filings, which are the same as the fees charged under the prior limited liability company act.
- **19 Abilities of board.** Clarifies that the board of a board-managed company does not need approval from members to engage in business activities, like granting a security interest in company assets and transfering assets to subsidiaries. Consistent with the prior limited liability company act, a board-managed company is only required to receive member approval for activities such as dissolution, merger, or conversion of the company.
- **20 Public benefit corporation.** Prohibits a company from converting into a public benefit corporation.
- **21, 22 Clarification.** Clarifies that a company can convert to a domestic or foreign company under the Revised Act, even if a foreign jurisdiction uses different terms to describe the conversion.
