## Overview

This bill follows the 2015 recodification of charter school laws creating a new statutory chapter 124E on charter schools. This bill proposes to make technical, grammatical, formatting, and other such non-substantive changes to chapter 124E. Nonpartisan staff in the revisor's office, the house, and the senate prepared the initial bill draft. Legislators, legislative staff, charter school stakeholders, and Minnesota Department of Education staff reviewed that initial draft and recommended changes, most of which the nonpartisan staff incorporated into a subsequent bill draft. This process is similar to the process used in 1998 to recodify the education code.
