Overview

This bill appropriates money for an assessment of advanced in-home activitymonitoring systems.

Section

1 Appropriation; Advanced In-Home Activity-Monitoring Systems. Appropriates \$40,000 in fiscal year 2017 from the general fund to the commissioner of human services for a grant to a research organization to conduct a comprehensive assessment of current literature, past research, and an environmental scan of the field related to advanced in-home activity-monitoring systems for elderly persons. Requires the commissioner to report the results of the assessment by January 15, 2017, to the legislative committees and divisions with jurisdiction over health and human services policy and finance. Specifies this is a onetime appropriation.
