Overview

This bill appropriates money for the home and community-based services incentive pool and instructs the revisor to codify the program. The incentive pool is an initiative to provide incentives for innovation in achieving integrated community employment, integrated living settings, and other outcomes as determined by the commissioner of human services.

Section

- 1** **Appropriation.** Appropriates \$8,656,000 in fiscal year 2017 from the general fund to the commissioner of human services for home and community-based services incentive payments. Sets the base appropriation for this program at \$8,500,000 in fiscal year 2018 and \$8,025,000 in fiscal year 2019.
- 2** **Revisor's Instruction.** Instructs the revisor to codify Laws 2015, ch. 71, art. 7, § 55 (home and community-based services incentive pool), as Minnesota Statutes, section 256B.0921.
