This bill would exempt excavations, caves, open/water-filled pits, and shafts from certain mine safety requirements (ex. fencing, barrier, signage requirements) if they meet one of the following criteria:

- (1) on property owned, leased or administered by the commissioner of Iron Range resources and rehabilitation;
- (2) for the construction, operation maintenance, or administration of: grant-in-aid trails, municipal park/trail/open space; or certain other recreational uses;
- (3) for certain economic development purposes; or
- (4) on property a county mine inspector has exempted provided certain conditions are met.

Establishes minimum signage requirements for areas that are exempted.
