Subject: State aid to counties with casinos

If the state has a tax agreement with a tribe, ten percent of the state share of tax collected under that agreement is paid to the county in which an Indian gaming casino is located. If the state does not have an agreement, five percent of the total amount of excise taxes collected on reservation activities is paid as aid instead. This bill doubles the percentages used to calculate casino aid payments to counties under current law.
