This bill narrows a 2015 law on permits issued to use of the right-of-way of a road to temporarily run a flexible pipe to apply manure to a field, so such that permits are only available for Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT) right-of-way (instead of the right-of-way of any road authority such a county, city, or town).

The permit provision allows for running the pipe for up to 14 days from the applicant's property to the field, including through any intervening landowners' property and subject to some statutory conditions.
