Duties (State Capitol Preservation Commission). Authorizes the State Capitol Preservation Commission to develop and implement a plan to reopen the Minnesota State Capitol. Authorizes the Commissioner of Administration to spend money appropriated by the legislature for Capitol restoration and preservation purposes in the same manner as private persons and entities make expenditures for these purposes. Provides that the current laws specifying procedures for gift acceptance do not apply to gifts for Capitol restoration and preservation. (The current laws specifying procedures for gift acceptance give the MMB commissioner certain authority to accept and administer gifts). Provides that appropriations of gift proceeds under this section do not cancel.
