Overview

This bill modifies terminology and asset limits related to the federal supplemental nutrition assistance program (SNAP). The name of the federal program was changed from Food Stamps to SNAP as of October 1, 2008, and the name federal Food Stamp Act of 1977 was updated to the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008.

Section

- 1 Income and asset limitations for supplemental nutrition assistance program (SNAP) households.** Amends § 256D.0515. Updates terminology and requires SNAP households to meet the federal asset limits, except that one licensed vehicle per household shall be excluded from the asset limit.
- 2 Revisor's instruction.** Instructs the revisor of statutes to change the terms "food support," "food stamp," and "food stamps" to "supplemental nutrition assistance program" or "SNAP" in Minnesota Statutes and Rules when appropriate. Allows the revisor to make technical and grammatical changes to preserve the meaning of the text.
