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Overview

This bill appropriates \$2.5 million per year for grants to the Sanneh Foundation to provide all-day, in-school, and after-school academic and behavioral interventions for low-performing and chronically absent students.

The bill authorizes the grant to be used to hire and train staff as mentors who provide behavior and academic support to students. The grants may also be used to encourage and support the mentors to become licensed teachers.
