Overview

The Anoka-Hennepin school district operates the Secondary Technical Education Program (STEP) in collaboration with and on the campus of the Anoka Technical College. The program is designed as a middle college program with an emphasis on career and technical courses. Students attending the program may receive college credit for courses through: (1) the concurrent enrollment program; (2) articulated college credit; and (3) letters of recommendation for college credit through technical skill attainment.

This bill appropriates \$200,000 in fiscal year 2018 from the general fund to the commissioner of education for a grant to Independent School District No. 11, Anoka-Hennepin, for the purchase of fabrication lab equipment and software.
