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Under current law, to qualify for the maximum benefit under the disabled veterans homestead exclusion, a veteran must have a total (100 percent) and permanent disability. HF 910 allows a veteran with a 100 percent and temporary disability to qualify for the maximum benefit as well. In addition, this bill increases the maximum benefit from \$300,000 of excluded market value to \$400,000. As amended, HF 910 would also allow the spousal benefit to the surviving spouse of a 100 percent and temporary disabled veteran and eliminate the annual application requirement for that benefit.
