### Overview

Under current state law, a sale of intoxicating liquor for on-premises consumption (on-sale) cannot be made after 2:00 a.m. or before 8:00 a.m. Sales between 1:00 a.m. and 2:00 a.m., or on Sunday between 8:00 a.m. and 2:00 a.m. require a separate permit or license. H.F. 1008 changes the time after which sales are prohibited under state law from 2:00 a.m. to 4:00 a.m.

#### Section

- 1 Intoxicating liquor; on-sale.** Changes the time after which intoxicating liquor may not be sold from 2:00 a.m. to 4:00 a.m.
- 2 Intoxicating liquor; Sunday sales; on-sale.** Amends the section of law providing for Sunday sales licenses to clarify that sales may be made until 4:00 a.m. on Monday.
- 3 Sales after 1:00 a.m.; permit fee.** Amends the section of law providing for a permit to sell intoxicating liquor between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 2:00 a.m. to clarify that sales may be made until 4:00 a.m. under this permit.
