H.F. 1091, as amended, requires the commissioner of revenue to deposit five percent of the revenue from the alcohol gross receipts tax to a newly created substance use disorder and alcohol abuse prevention account. Beginning July 1, 2019, half of this amount is annually appropriated to the commissioner of human services to fund activities related to substance use disorder prevention and half is appropriated to the commissioner of health for alcohol abuse prevention.
