Appropriates money for grants to local communities to increase the supply of childcare, with priority for communities with a documented shortage of child care providers. At least 60 percent of the funds must go to communities in greater Minnesota and grant recipients must supply a 50 percent nonstate match in cash or in-kind contributions. Requires reports to the legislature on program outcomes.
