This bill directs MnDOT to study the feasibility of expanding a stretch of Trunk Highway 371 to four lanes from Jenkins to Cass Lake. It specifies study elements, including identifying obstacles to expansion, suggesting potential routes, identifying various potential impacts, and estimating costs. A legislative report on the study is due by December 15, 2017.

The bill also appropriates \$4 million from the trunk highway fund in fiscal year 2018 for the study.
