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**Subject:** School district health insurance coverage

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### Overview

This bill makes changes to the process school districts use to receive proposals for group health insurance coverage for their employees and under what circumstances a school district is considered self-insured.

#### Section

- 1 **Paragraph (b), (f) Requests.** Removes the requirement that school districts request a proposal from the public employee insurance program (PEIP).  
**Paragraph (c) Contract length.** Allows school districts to have health insurance contracts up to four years in length.  
**Paragraph (g) Joint powers.** Removes the provision which provides that a school district will not be considered self-insured for purposes of this subdivision solely by participating in a joint powers arrangement.  
**Paragraph (i) Exclusive representative abilities.** Requires the exclusive representative for the largest group of employees to comply with the requirements of the school district group health insurance bidding process in this subdivision, notwithstanding any abilities they may have provided by section 43A.316, subdivision 5 or otherwise.  
Effective. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
- 2 **Jointly.** Removes the provision which provides that a self-insurance pool operated by one or more service cooperatives is not considered self-insured for purposes of section 471.6161, subdivision 8.  
Effective. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
