Overview

This bill modifies the postsecondary enrollment options (PSEO) program. High school students in PSEO take college classes for college credit either at the college or university, or online.

Section

- 1 Enrollment priority.** Eliminates limits on postsecondary institutions' ability to advertise or recruit high school students.
- 2 Access to computers.** Requires a school to provide a student enrolled in PSEO and concurrent enrollment courses the same access to computers and software that it provides to other students in the school.
- 3 Credits; grade point average weighting dispute.** Allows a student to appeal a school board's decision regarding a weighted grade point average for a particular course to the commissioner of education.
- 4 Eligible programs.** Allows students that qualify for graduation incentives program to enroll in charter schools.
