Overview

Under current law, county auditors are required to mail a notice of registration to all voters who registered in a polling place on election day. This bill requires each county auditor to provide the secretary of state with certain data related to the number of notices that were returned as undeliverable.

In addition to the total number of undeliverable notices, the data must itemize notices that were undeliverable for a reason that the county auditor could determine, and notices that were undeliverable for a reason that the county auditor could not determine.

The secretary must use this information to submit a report to the legislature by March 1 of each odd-numbered year.
