Overview

This bill permits the use of an electronic polling place roster system that features an ability of the voter to sign in to vote electronically, rather than by singing a physical piece of paper.

If a voter registration application is an electronic record that is also signed electronically, the roster system must provide for a printed copy that indicates the existence of the voter's electronic signature.

The bill also includes standards for retention of election documents containing electronic voter signatures.
