Overview

This bill appropriates money from the fire safety account in the special revenue fund to the commissioner of public safety for a variety of fire safety purposes. The fire safety account is funded by a fire safety surcharge on homeowners insurance policies.

Section

- **Fire safety account; appropriations.** Appropriates \$12,960,000 each year from the fire safety account to the commissioner of public safety. Of this amount:
 - (1) \$4,263,000 each year is to fund the Minnesota Board of Firefighter Training and Education;
 - (2) \$7,097,000 each year is to fund the state fire marshal;
 - (3) \$500,000 each year is to fund Minnesota Task Force 1;
 - (4) \$850,000 each year is transferred to the Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management to fund chemical assessment and emergency response teams; and
 - (5) \$250,000 each year is to fund the Minnesota Air Rescue Team (MART).
