Allows journeyman electricians (section 1) and unlicensed individuals (section 2) to do work for a different employer than the employer of the person required to supervise their work, as long as the journeyman electrician or unlicensed individual is: (1) covered by workers' compensation; (2) is the subject of unemployment insurance contributions; and, as under current law, (3) is supervised doing the work (4) under the required safety standards. Permits the employer of the supervisor of the journeyman electrician or unlicensed individual to verify and report the supervised hours for licensing purposes.
