This bill permits flashing red lights on the vehicle of a volunteer emergency responder (for a fire department volunteer, emergency medical first responder, or ambulance crew member), when responding to an emergency call.

Under current law, a red light is permitting to be displayed to the front of the vehicle but flashing lights are not explicitly authorized (and such lights are prohibited with some exceptions specified in statute).
