A 2008 special law authorized the Northwest Minnesota Multicounty Housing and Redevelopment Authority to impose a levy of up to 25% of the statutory limit without obtaining the required consent of the governing bodies of each political subdivision. The statutory limit is .0185% of the estimated market value in a political subdivision.

Initially, this special levy authority was set to expire after taxes payable in 2014, but was extended by the legislature in 2013, to taxes payable in 2019. Under H.F. 2909, the housing authority would be able to use its special levy authority until taxes payable in 2024.
