Subject: Temporary motor vehicle permits

This bill extends the validity time period for three types of temporary motor vehicle permits, to make them valid for six months following the date of issuance (instead of the 21-day, 31-day, or 60-day periods set for each kind of permit). The extension applies to those permits that are valid at the time of enactment of the provision, as well as to permits issued through the end of 2018.

The permits are:

- a 21-day permit issued in conjunction with new or used vehicle purchases;
- a 60-day permit for expiring registration and plate replacement; and
- a 31-day permit for vehicle purchases by nonresidents (when removing the vehicle from the state). Minn. Stat. §§ 168.09, subd. 7; 168.091; 168.092.

The extension would go into effect the day after enactment.
