Overview

Under section 245A.06, subdivision 8, licensed family child care providers and child care centers are required to post a correction order or order of conditional license in a visible place in the facility for two years, with some exceptions. If passed, this bill would remove the requirement to physically post a correction order, and remove additional provisions relating to the posting of correction orders.

Section

1 Requirement to post correction order. Amends § 245A.06, subdivision 8. Removes requirement to post correction orders, and removes paragraphs (b) and (c), which only apply to the posting of correction orders.
