## - Bill Summary -

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This bill, if passed, would require the Council of Health Boards to convene a work group to study and make recommendations on increasing access to clinical experience using telehealth technologies in postsecondary counseling-related educational programs. The bill specifies that the work group must consist of representatives of the Boards of Psychology, Social Work, Marriage and Family Therapy, and Behavioral Health and Therapy, postsecondary educational institutions, and the relevant professional counseling associations. The bill also appropriates money and requires that the work group submit its recommendations to the legislative committees with jurisdiction over health occupations and higher education.
