Overview

This bill allows an automated kiosk to purchase used cell phones and pay the seller in cash if certain requirements are met.

Section

1 **Payment for used wireless communications devices.** Allows an automated kiosk that purchases used cell phones to pay cash to the seller if the kiosk: is monitored by a live representative; verifies the seller's identity; stores the cell phones appropriately; captures images of the seller, the seller's identification, and the device; electronically reports all transactions to law enforcement; reads identification numbers on cell phones; and is only used to purchase cell phones.

Effective date. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
