Subject: Supplemental point source implementation grants

Under the current point source implementation grant program, the maximum grant amount is \$7 million to cover up to 80 percent of project costs. Minn. Stat. § 446A.073, subd. 1.

This bill provides for a supplemental grant award from the point source implementation grant program if the combined sources of funding from the Water Infrastructure Funding (WIF) program, the point source implementation grant program, and any other state or federal grants, is less than (1) 50 percent of total project costs, or (2) the amount needed to reduce the annual cost per household for the wastewater system in the project service area to no more than twice what it is in the metropolitan area. The supplemental grant would be an amount so that the combined total of grants is at least one of those measures.

The Public Facilities Authority must estimate and report to the legislature each year the amount needed to cover WIF and point source implementation grants.

The bill appropriates an unspecified amount from the bond proceeds fund for grants under this subdivision.
