The open meeting law allows a meeting to be conducted by interactive television under certain conditions. One of the conditions is that each location at which a member of the governing body is present be open and accessible to the public.

This bill modifies that condition so it does not apply to a member who is also in the military and at a required drill, deployed, or on active duty, or to a member with a medical condition that requires the member to avoid being in public places.
