Requires Hennepin County to share the revenue it collects from its 0.5 percent local transportation tax requested by certain cities. Cities that have a planned or operating transit line located in the city would not be eligible to share in the transportation tax revenue.

Any other city with a population of 60,000 or more that is partially or wholly located within the county may by resolution, require Hennepin County to remit to the city 50 percent of the county sales tax revenue collected within the city. The city must use the money for improvements to county highways and bridges in the portion of the city located in the county.

The only cities that would qualify for transportation tax sharing under this bill are Maple Grove and Plymouth.
