Overview

The commissioner of corrections charges 65 percent of the per diem cost of confinement of juveniles to all counties and can charge the full cost of confinement to Community Corrections Act (CCA) counties. The money received by the commissioner must be deposited in the general fund. This bill adjusts the formula for calculating the per diem cost and repeals the section authorizing the commissioner to charge the full cost of confinement to CCA counties.

Section

- 1 Charges to counties.** Removes the requirement that expenses and revenue balance over a two-year period from the formula used to calculate the per diem cost of confinement for juveniles committed to the commissioner or corrections.
- 2 Repealer.** Repeals section 401.13 which directs the commissioner to charge CCA counties the full per diem cost for juveniles confined in a state correctional facility.
