Overview

The safe schools levy allows school districts to levy for costs associated with student and staff safety issues. Eligible expenses include:

- law enforcement liaison services (School Resource Officers)
- drug abuse prevention programs (DARE)
- gang resistance education training
- school security
- other crime prevention and student and staff safety measures, and
- counseling, social work, and chemical dependency services provided by licensed professionals.

Under current law, the safe schools levy equals \$36 per pupil plus for members of an intermediate school district, up to \$15 per pupil unit for safe schools activities at the intermediate school district.

H.F. 3599 increases the safe schools levy by an unspecified amount.
