This bill prohibits a county, home rule charter or statutory city, or town from adopting or enforcing an ordinance that regulates or prohibits the sale or use of “auxiliary containers” or that imposes a fee on the use, disposition, or sale of auxiliary containers.

Effective the day after enactment and provides that ordinances in effect at that time are void and unenforceable.

An “auxiliary container” is, for example, a take-out container or a cup or bottle for drink from a restaurant or store and may be made of any material.
