### Overview

This bill removes language from chapter 103I that authorizes licensed plumbers to repair pumps or water pipes associated with a well water system in certain circumstances. It also requires a report of well or boring construction or sealing to be submitted to the commissioner of health within 90 days, rather than 30 days, of completing the work.

#### Section

- 1** **License required.** Amends § 103I.205, subd. 4. Removes language authorizing a licensed plumber who does not have a well or boring contractor's license under chapter 103I to repair submersible pumps or water pipes connected to well water systems if the repair location is in an area with no licensed well contractors within 50 miles, provided the plumber complies with the plumbing code.
- 2** **Report of work.** Amends § 103I.205, subd. 9. Updates the deadline for submitting a report to the commissioner of health related to well or boring construction or sealing to within 90 days, rather than 30 days, of completing the work.
