When the Workers' Compensation Court of Appeals, which decides cases under Minnesota's workers' compensation laws, has insufficient judges to make a quorum, this bill allows retired workers' compensation and administrative law judges to serve. The Workers' Compensation Court of Appeals consists of five judges, with three being a quorum.

This bill was approved by the Workers' Compensation Advisory Council.
