House File 6, as amended by the H0006DE1 amendment, increases the number of members on the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission from five to nine, eight of whom are to represent each of the state's Congressional districts, with one commissioner serving at-large. Commissioners will continue to be appointed by the governor, with the advice and consent of the Senate, and to serve six-year terms. All current commissioners will serve out their terms. Four new commissioners will be appointed to terms beginning in January 2018, with one appointment made each year for the next five years, to replace current commissioners as their term expires.
