### Overview

This bill establishes a constitutional right to carry firearms in Minnesota and creates an optional permit to carry based on the current permit to carry statute.

#### **Section**

1	<b>No permit required.</b> Declares that any person who is not prohibited from possessing a firearm may carry a firearm in public.
2	<b>Optional carry permit.</b> Converts the current permit to carry statute from compulsory to optional.
3	<b>Permit application.</b> Contains a conforming amendment to reflect the optional nature of permits to carry.
4	<b>Form of application.</b> Contains a conforming amendment to reflect the optional nature of permits to carry.
5	<b>Permit card expiration.</b> Contains a conforming amendment to reflect the optional nature of permits to carry.
6	<b>Commissioner; contracts; database.</b> Contains conforming amendments to reflect the optional nature of permits to carry.
7	<b>Monitoring.</b> Contains conforming amendments to reflect the optional nature of permits to carry.
8	<b>Exclusivity.</b> Contains conforming amendments to reflect the optional nature of permits to carry.

#### Repealer. Repeals:

(1) the requirement that a permit to carry is required and the penalty for carrying a firearm in public without a permit;

(2) the requirements regarding the display of permits to carry;

(3) repeals the requirement that the commissioner of public safety must recognize certain permits from other states; and

(4) the prohibition on carrying rifles and shotguns in public places.
