Overview

This bill creates a special license plate for retired law enforcement.

Section

1 [168.1256] Special retired law enforcement plates. Creates a new section of statutes establishing a special plate for retired law enforcement. Application and issuance of the plate would begin January 1, 2018.

Subd. 1. Issuance of plates. Sets requirements to obtain the special plate, including ownership of an eligible passenger-type vehicle or motorcycle, availability only for retired peace officers, proof of eligibility via a letter from a chief, and payment of a \$10 fee as well as other applicable fees and taxes.

Subd. 2. Design. Directs the Department of Public Safety to design the graphics and inscriptions for the plate, in consultation with interested law enforcement agencies and organizations.

Subd. 3. Plates transfer. Sets requirements and a \$5 fee for transferring the plate to another vehicle.

Subd. 4. Exemption. Exempts the plates from application requirements governing new special license plate proposals, including a survey, marketing strategy, and application fee.
