Appropriates \$100,000 in each year of the biennium to the commissioner of public safety for training state and local community safety personnel in the use of crisis de-escalation techniques. The commissioner must consult with the Minnesota Peace Officers and Training Board, and may consult with other relevant individuals, when selecting a training service provider. The training service provider must have a demonstrated understanding of veterans' issues. The training opportunities must be provided statewide.
