Overview

This bill identifies tampering with a public safety motor vehicle as a crime and outlines the criminal penalties for being found guilty of such a crime.

Section

- Criminal damage to property in the first degree. Creates a five year felony for damage to a public safety motor vehicle that results in a substantial interruption or impairment of a service offered by the affected public safety agency or a reasonably foreseeable risk of bodily harm.
- **Criminal damage to property in the third degree.** Creates a gross misdemeanor for knowingly damaging a public safety motor vehicle.
- **Definitions.** Defines "public safety motor vehicle" and "damage."
