Overview

This bill makes disability license plates available for mopeds, with the associated requirements applying in the same manner as for motorcycles. Mopeds, referred to as motorized bicycles in state law, are motorized devices with a 50 cc engine and a top speed of 30 miles per hour. Among the regulations for mopeds, the vehicles must be registered with the state and an operator's permit or driver's license is required.

- **1 Disability plates; application.** Adds motorized bicycles as a type of vehicle for which a person can apply for disability plates.
- 2 Plate design; furnished by commissioner. Provides for a single disability plate on motorized bicycles.
- **3 Plate transfer.** Makes a conforming change.
- **4 Scope of privilege.** Makes a conforming change.
- 5 **Identifying certificate.** Makes a conforming change.
- **6 Effective date.** Makes the changes effective January 1, 2018.
